Instructions for PhD Candidates-2012

17th May, 2012

- ❖ Every successful candidate of PhD entrance-2012 will be required to make a presentation on his/ her proposed research area.
- ❖ A candidate may contact approved supervisors to discuss his/ her research area. He/She can specify his/her preferred supervisor out of the list of approved supervisors.
- ❖ The final allocation of each candidate to a supervisor shall be done by the GTU.
 - **The detail schedule of presentations will be displayed on the GTU website in due course of time.**
- ❖ The PhD Candidates are expected to include the following in their presentation:
 - Proposed Topic of Research
 - Broad area of Research,
 - Literature Review comprising of Journal papers which indicate the need for the research,
 - Objectives and broad scope of research.
 - Names of at least 2 GTU approved PhD Supervisors in the area of proposed research
 - Candidates are required to submit hard copy of research proposal which includes above details at the time of interview along with their PPT presentation.
- ❖ Once a candidate has been allocated to a supervisor, he/she will be required to complete all the requirements for pre- registration for the PhD program. The requirements will include filling up the forms, paying his/her fees at the University etc.
- ❖ **The academic session for the PhD program will be displayed on the GTU website in due course of time.**
- ❖ The Course Work shall comprise of (1) Research Methodology (RM) and (ii) Core subject/ subjects as prescribed by his/her the Supervisor. Core Subject will be evaluated by the Doctoral Progress Committee (DPC), before the end of second semester.
- ❖ RM classes may be conducted at L. D. College of Engg., Ahmedabad on every Saturday & Sunday. However, the detail schedule will be displayed on the GTU website. To be eligible for appearing in Course work exam the candidate is required to have at least 75% attendance. Failing to which, he/she will not be allowed to appear in exam.
- ❖ Once a candidate has successfully completed Ph.D. Course Work he/she shall have to make a presentation of their final topic of Research along with a comprehensive literature review, objectives, scope, work plan and work done so far. The Final registration will be done only if his/her research proposal is approved by the DPC.
