

B.Pharm Norms for passing

Each Subject is equally weighted for theory and practical component.

1. Every theory and practical component is divided into two parts. Internal and External. Internal exam for theory is identified as Mid semester exam (20%) followed by remedial exam. Internal component in practical carries 20% practical weight age, which is accessed by the internal college teacher.
2. Minimum passing for any component is 40%, subject to condition of 50% aggregate requirement for semester passing. (i.e 1100 total marks student has to obtain minimum 50% marks = 550 marks for semester passing)
3. If a student gets more than or equal 50% marks in all the heads in all the subjects – he/she is pass.
4. If a students gets 40% in some heads/subjects but aggregate is more than 50% then also student is considered as pass.
5. Less than 40% in any head or subject is failure. That has to be clear in remedial.
6. If student aggregate is less than 50% but more than 40% in all heads, then overall semester result is fail. Student has to reappear in exam to improve aggregate. He/she can take remedial exam in the subject with grade (CC/CD). Maximum number of subject one can take is three and fresh score will always be considered as the latest one.
7. Student shall not continue his/her further study, if he/she is having more than 4 backlogs (Maximum Three in theory) only after the declaration of remedial exam result.
