

Faculty Development Program by ‘Wipro Mission 10x’ for GTU affiliated colleges.

An advance workshop on Faculty Empowerment is organized by Wipro Mission 10x (Wipro India Ltd) to be held at GTU affiliated colleges. The **Five day Faculty empowerment workshop** is to polish and train the faculty for innovative teaching and learning skills. Mission 10x is a “not for profit trust” created by Wipro to enhance the employability of Engineering graduates in India.

Vision: “Mission 10X” is a quantum innovation project for enhancing employability of engineering graduates in India through innovation. The vision is to increase the employability of students by 10 times. The Program enables college faculty with new and alternate training methodologies that provides input to a faculty to become a mentor, guide and a facilitator in the class and thus prepare their students to become more employable. The facilitators from engineering background who get deprived of any formal training on teaching are introduced to different teaching aids and methodologies which can be used in class room, so that the conventional teaching gets transforms to innovative teaching.

Registration: Two colleges are welcome to host in this program in the month of June & July. Four colleges can participate in each program. (Total 35 participants from four colleges in one program). The other terms and conditions are

- a) Faculty from the engineering and computer science branch (but not language, applied sciences or management) are welcome to participate in programs.
- b) Faculty should have minimum 3 years of experience (teaching / non teaching)

Salient Features:

- a) Implementation of innovative teaching methodologies.
- b) Faculty members will be eligible to obtain 3 international certificates.
 - Mission10X Dale Carnegie Certificate in High impact Teaching Skills

- Cambridge International Certificate for Teacher and Trainers
- Mission10X Certificate in Teaching and Learning

c) Invitation to Master Trainer's Program at Bangalore, on merit basis for practitioners

d) Train their peer at college level.

e) Opportunity to get published on Mission10X portal through case studies.

f) Participate in Learning Forums.

g) Invitation to annual regional/national Educator's Meet.

h) Other academic initiatives like Academic Leadership Program for the principals and directors (designed for senior academicians).

GTU will appreciate the participation of the faculty in the program and emphasizes the importance of such Faculty Development Programs which will be a great help in taking the teaching methodology to a high level.

Note: The institutes are invited to organize Mission 10x program at their respective institutes.
