A Report

A five days (4-8 July, 2011) faculty empowerment program was organized in collaboration with Wipro Mission 10 X at L. D. College of Engineering for faculties of degree engineering colleges. A total of 31 faculties participated, out of which 11 faculties were from Government Engineering College, Gandhinagar and the rest 20 were from L. D. College of Engineering, Ahmadabad. The group was from Mechanical, Civil, Applied mechanics, Electronics and Communication, Electrical, Instrumentation and Control, Computer, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Plastic Technology and Metallurgy departments.

The program focused mainly on High Impact Teaching Skills and Active Learning Methods to increase the employability of the students.
