The first meeting of the GTU MBA Skill council for "Financial Services", "Human Resource Studies & Organization Structures", & "Marketing" was held on **Friday**, **13.05.2011** at Gujarat Technological University. 40 Directors/HODs and Trustees of various Colleges have attended meeting with the purpose of formation of various Councils namely for New 21st Century MBA program of GTU.

Meeting was chaired and coordinated by **Dr. Rajesh Khajuria**, Director, CKSV Institute of Management, Vadodara at the request of **Dr. Akshai Aggarwal**, Vice Chancellor, GTU.

Prof. Almas Juneja, Syllabus Coordinator, GTU welcomed all Directors, Professors and Managing Trustees present.

Ms Krutika Desai shall be the GTU Coordinator for Skill Development Councils.

Following Illustrative objectives & activities of GTU MBA Skill Council were discussed in the Meeting with the Honorable Vice Chancellor of Gujarat Technological University.

Objectives:

- 1. To improve the employability of the students graduating from Management Schools.
- 2. To facilitate the students in getting valuable assignments for Summer Internship.
- 3. To jointly develop Case Studies.
- 4. To develop Industry academic and create more focus on skills rather than Functions.
- 5. To identify Sub Sector Skills.
- 6. To identify colleges / Champions to specialize in each skill and then train others.

Special Remarks:

- 1. Case Studies, and

Students can take up case studies. About 50% of MBA students have chosen Finance specialization, which means about 4,000/- students approximately who study in GTU MBA Colleges in Gujarat. If each student takes up one Industry for studying, and prepare a case study with the help of teacher, we can have up to 4,000 Case Studies which can be uploaded at **GTU Cloud website**.

3. Plan to organise FDP during June – July 2011 if possible.

- 4. Sub–Sector Council will be representative of entire country
- 5. Syllabus of Bank's Training Centres should be studied and comments may be given
- 6. Include Case Studies as essential part in teaching
- 7. Teaching MBA Program for 5 hour shift will not work
- 8. GTU MBA should compete with IIMs and leading Management Institutions
- 9. Drive students to excel to work hard.
