The reasons for the fall of demand may be the uneven quality of education. Another may be a less than complete understanding that the needs of an MBA program are quite different from the needs of a standard 2-year educational program, based on book-learning and examinations.

The Workshop will try to jointly determine both the causes and the remedies.
