After post lunch session, **10 team members project** which were found patentable, completed their drafting with help of expert. They are going to file their patent within few days.

Mr. Hiranmay Mahanta, GTU Innovation council, motivated the students to come forward with their invention and assure that GTU will provide all kind of support to draft and file their patents. Further, he also mentioned that once students will have patent, then GTU will support them to transfer their technology to potential buyers.
