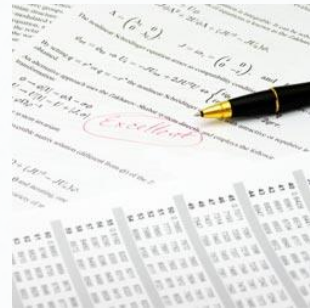
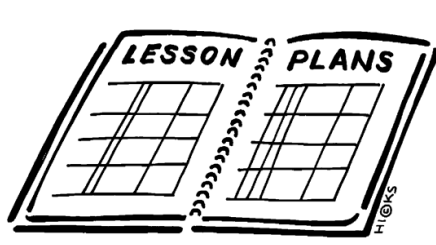

# FEW WEEKS BEFORE THE EXAMINATION





- ***Practice Writing*** Neatly & Speedily,
- Practise Solving ***Previous*** / Sample ***Question Papers***,
- Measure your Speed of Writing ***One Page, One Question / Sub Question***,
- Allocate the ***Time appropriate to the Marks*** assigned to one Question / Sub Question,
- Always start a ***New Question / Sub Question*** from ***New page***
- Number the answer as per the question: ***Ans. 1 – (a)***
- Write the ***Contents*** as ***asked*** and ***not as you desire***.



- Examiner expects precise and correct answer,
- Keep your answer stepwise,
- Prepare Skeleton outline,
- Use fact, figure, quotation, table etc. for logical & systematic Answering,
- Give equal importance to all questions.



## Routine

- **180 Minutes & 70 Marks**
- ~~**= 2.6 Minutes / Mark**~~
- **5 Main Questions (10 Sub Questions),**
- ~~**2.6 x 7 Marks = 18 Minutes**~~ for Each Sub Question,
- **32 Pages** in Main Answer Script + **Infinite,**
- **2.6 to 8 Minutes** per page,
- **5 to 2 Pages** per Sub Question,
- Hence **10 to 4 Pages** per Main Question
- Hence **50 to 20 Pages** for all Questions

## Ideal

- **160 Minutes & 70 Marks**
- **= 2.3 Minutes / Mark**
- **5 Main Questions (10 Sub Questions)**
- **2.3 x 7 Marks = 16 Minutes** for Each Sub Question
- Varying from **32 to 52 pages** in Total
- Ideally **5.3 Minutes** per Page
- Ideally **3 Pages** per Sub Question
- Hence Ideally **6 Pages** per Main Question
- Hence Ideally **30 Pages** for all Questions



# FEW DAYS BEFORE THE EXAMINATION



- Prepare a ***time table for revision***
- Make your notes more ***user friendly***
- Find out the ***appropriate way of revision***
- Look at ***previous examination papers***
- ***feel comfortable.***



- Collect ***new notes*** and material from friends.
- Read and ***learn till last minute*** without time for revision.
- ***Sit for longer hours.***
- ***Excessive use*** of Coffee or tea

# ON THE DAY OF EXAMINATION

## Do's

- Have a *light* but adequate *breakfast*.
- Check *all the necessary things* – *Hall – Ticket*, Pens, Pencils, geometry box, Etc.
- *Reach* the examination hall *well in advance*.
- Attend Nature's Call before entering the examination hall.
- Take deep breaths and keep yourself *relaxed*.

## Don'ts

- *Skip* your *Breakfast*,
- *Get Frustrated* for unknown study portion
- *Allow Negative Thoughts*
- *Rely on Rumors of "Important Questions" only*
- *Make Revision just before entering* examination hall.
- *Talk about the Subject*
- *Remember Earlier Poor Performance*

# IN THE EXAMINATION HALL

- Be *Positive*,
- Take time to *settle down* once entered in the Exam Hall,
- Check the surroundings and remove *uneven / non-belongings things*,
- write your *personal information* very carefully,
- Keep *Hall Ticket* Ready,
- Read the Question Paper with Patience,
- *Read the directions* carefully, *clarify your Doubts*,
- *Plan the Answer* for each question,
- *Allocate time* appropriate to marks,
- Attempt *Simple Questions* First,
- Allocate More Time to *Challenging Questions*,
- Make Sure to Attempt *Required No. of Questions*



# IN THE EXAMINATION HALL

- Select First the *best known questions*,
- *If you don't know a question, move on the next*,
- *Leave space* after each answer so that you can write later if you need to,
- Focus on *Quality* and Not Quantity *Writings*,
- Try to *Finish* the Paper a little *Early & Do Proof Reading*.
- *Highlight important points* – underline, write in capital etc.
- Never Leave / Mention Any *identity* in the Answer Book

- ✓ Smart
- ✓ Neat & Clean
- ✓ Well Organised
- ✓ Attention Grabbing
- ✓ All Revealing
