Prof. Manish Gaharwar explained through a presentation to the Business Women Wing about the advantages of having a website and what GTU students of different branches can do for them. **He also promised GCCI to help them with almost 100 websites for their members in 2013. They have delivered more than 40 websites by now as per the inputs obtained.**
