GTU has implemented a new Global MBA program since August 2011. This program requires immersion studies and preparation of reports and case studies in different subjects. GTU's new MBA Program has three characteristics: Global, Innovative and Skill-oriented.

GCSR (Global Country Study Report) program has been introduced, as a 2-semester study program during the 3rd and the 4th semesters of the 4-semester MBA program. GTU has decided that it would focus on the study of business inter-actions with African and Asian countries in its GCSR program.
