#### **OBJECTIVES OF THE PROGRAM**

The objective of this workshop is to give Hands-on-training to faculty members of GTU affiliated Engineering Colleges on "Patent Search & Analysis Report Generation", which is a part of Phase III of online project tracking system. Phase III is based on study of patents related to every student's IDP/UDP and its online report generation.

By attending this workshop, faculty can guide their respective students in a better way about how to read and study patent; how to prepare online report and how to prepare Summary of 5 related patents.
