5th Report regarding seminars organized by various GTU affiliated colleges for the Final Year BE students on Patent Drafting Exercise (PDE)

To implement Patent Drafting Exercise (PDE) effectively, GTU Innovation Council (GIC) had organized six Faculty Development Programs (FDPs). These were conducted at GTU Chandkheda's campus on 15.02.2014 & 08.03.2014 and four zonal levels FDP at Atmiya Institute of Technology & Science - Rajkot on 22.03.2014, Parul Institute of Technology - Baroda on 29.03.2014, BVM Engineering College - VV Nagar, Anand on 05.04.2014 and at Sarvajanik College of Engineering and Technology - Surat on 12.04.2013.
